# **The Downtown District and Waterfront**

The continued focus of connecting the waterfront to downtown was evident in 2018. One of downtown's biggest needs was the complete repair of Reid Avenue. Reid Avenue had not been touched in about 24 years so it was in rough shape. The PSJRA funded the complete reconstruction of Reid constructed through the road bond but to be repaid by the PSJRA over the next two fiscal years. We also replaced the some of the landscaping in planter beds where folks actually walk so it makes for a much safer pedestrian area. The existing (original) CRA sunset in 2020 and the new focus is on the extended boundary.
